

Our house rules

to affect the well-being of us all

and to guarantee a joyful restaurant visit

Dear guests & friends of the Villa Merton,
the following information states shortly all current house rules,
drawn up pursuant to the Coronavirus Protection Ordinance.

We are looking forward to your visit!

1. Please *reserve your table in advance* via phone +49 (0) 69 – 703033 or Open Table / our homepage.
We are happy to serve you between 12 noon and 2 p.m. (*last reservation time 1.30 p.m.*) and 6 p.m. to 10.30 p.m. (*last reservation time 8 p.m.*).
2. At your arrival, *please keep the minimum distance of 1,50m* even though you are still outside of the building.
3. Please ring the bell – we will open the door to welcome you.
4. The following rules apply up to an incidence of 350: **2 G regulation** indoors:
* Obligation to provide evidence
Complete vaccination before 14 days
Or Recovered for at least 28 days / max. 6 months ago and identity card.
Current negative evidence for children and young people between 6 to 17 years of age (with current negative rapid antigen test - not older than 24 hours or by submitting the school test booklet).
5. From an incidence of 350: **2 G-Plus** control indoors:
* Obligation to provide evidence
Complete vaccination before 14 days
Or Recovered for at least 28 days / max. 6 months ago and *current negative rapid antigen test* – (not older than 24 hours) and identity card.
Current negative evidence for children and young people between 6 to 17 years of age (with current negative rapid antigen test - not older than 24 hours).
 - The rapid antigen test is not required for people who have already received a (third) booster vaccination (see separated pdf for booster regulations).
6. If required, we can provide a self-test for a service fee of € 8.00 / person. Please add approx. 20 minutes for your reservation time.
7. Please disinfect your hands using the dispenser provided at the entrance.
8. Please wear *a medical face mask* when entering our house until you are seated at your table. The mouth and nose protection must also be worn when going to the toilet and when leaving the house, i.e. in all public areas.
9. Our service staff will guide you to your seat.
10. Due to the constantly changing rules, please inquire about the current regulations by telephone.
